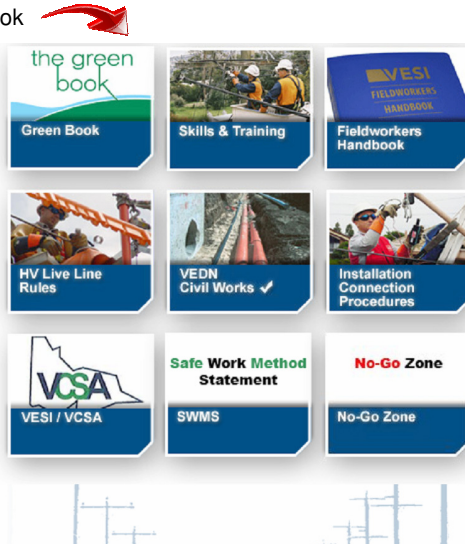
Imminent Revision of the 2006 Green Book

The Green Book Committee advises that revision of the 2006 Green Book is expected to commence in early 2010 and hence invites comments and suggestions for consideration.

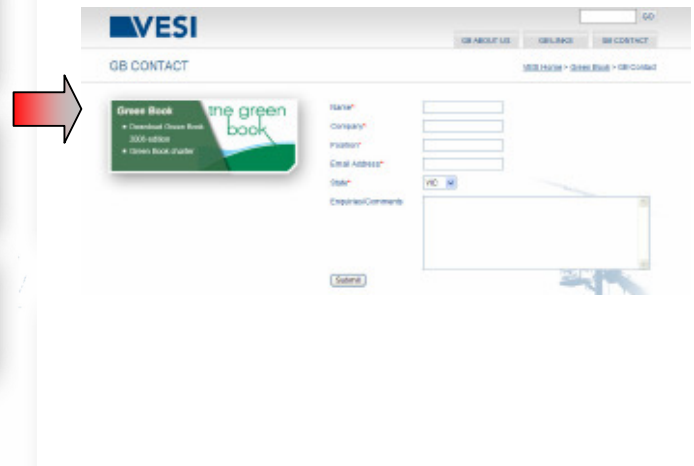
